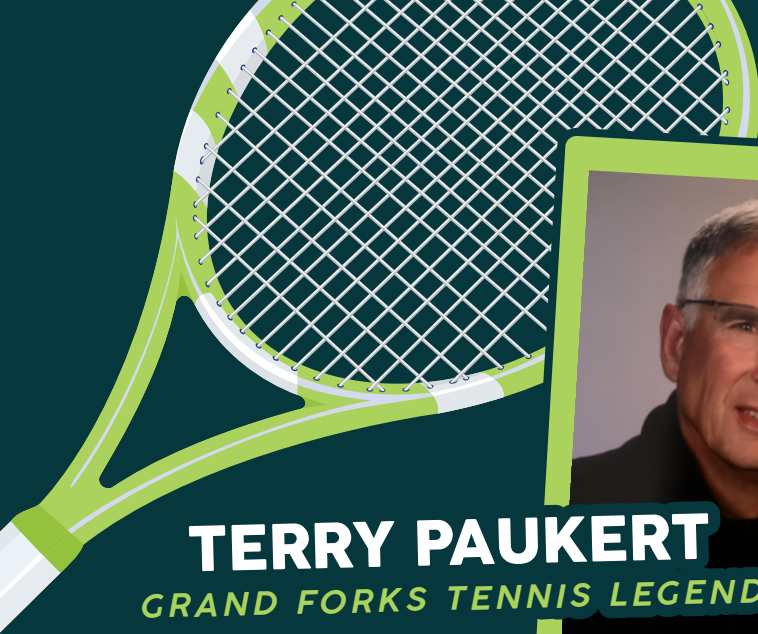

Terry worked as a high school teacher for many years and coached numerous hockey and tennis teams in the community. In recognition of his efforts to develop strong, confident athletes he was the recipient of the United States Tennis Association C. Burton Junior Development Award. Despite retiring in 2012, Terry continues to volunteer his time coaching young athletes of all ages free of charge at Riverside Park each summer, which has affectionately been dubbed “Terry Tennis” by his players.
